Year 11 History

Overview: The two-year History course is designed to prepare students for their EDEXCEL iGCSE History examinations. The course is assessed via two external examinations at the end of Year 11. The topics selected have been designed to give students a detailed understanding of four fascinating periods in history, but also to enable them to better understand the world in which we live today.

The second year of the course will focus on Paper 2. This consist of a historical investigation into the origins and course of World War 1 and a breadth study in change exploring conflict, crisis and change in The Middle East from 1917 – 2009.

This paper is worth 50% of the overall GCSE grade.
