

Year 9 History

Overview: The Year 9 History course focuses on the two most important world events of the 20th Century – WW1 and WW2. The course will provide students with a solid understanding of the 20th Century which will help them to put areas of study at iGCSE level into a broader context. Students will learn about the causes, course and consequences of World War One. Named "The war to end all wars," few anticipated that its aftermath would pave the way for extremism and an even more deadly world war in its wake.
